Matt is a Director of Photography with 17+ years experience in cinematography, lighting and video editing. "The Odds" is Matt's directorial debut and is a concept short for his feature film project "Rivet".

Matt has DoP'd 4 feature films, 40+ short films (one of which won best NZ & Wellington regional cinematography at the 2016 'HP48Hour' film competition and many others being screened in festivals all over the world), music videos and countless corporate & training videos.

Lighting experience includes on-set work on *Avatar, King Kong, The Waterhorse, X-Men 3* VFX unit and more. Notable corporate clients; FIFA, CocaCola Amatil, actor Stephen Fry, BP, DoC, Wellington Phoenix, NZ Defense Force, Government House Wellington and The Crown.

He has DoP'd 4 feature films, the first called "When Night Falls" which had a 20 cinema & DVD release in NZ, shown on Air NZ international flights, and released in America & Canada on DVD in 2010. The second is Alex Galvin's "Eternity" which has had its world premiere in competition at the Festival des Antipodes Festival in Saint-Tropez, France. Further to this, "Eternity" is one of the Festival's selection for Cannes Cinephiles which recently screened at the Cannes Film Festival this year. It also won the 'special jury prize' at the California Film Awards, 'audience award' at the Boston Sci-Fi film festival & won 2 awards (nominated for 4) at the Madrid Film Festival in Spain among screening and other international film festivals.

Matt was Director of Photography on the acclaimed web series "Life In The Dead Zone" and also worked on the feature film "Before The Darkness".

Matt has collaborated with writer/producer April Phillips for several years on her award-winning short films "The Last Man on Earth", "Letter for Hope", "Utu Pihikete" and "REM". These films have screened at some of the world's most prestigious genre/horror/sci-fi film festivals including Fantasia, Screamfest, FilmQuest, Fantastic Planet/Night of Horror, Horror Hound and Sci-Fi London.

#### **PELHAM FILMS – Matthew Mawkes**



Matthew arrived in Wellington in 2000, at a time when the city was fast becoming New Zealand's filmmaking capital. There he attended a crash course at Avalon Film & TV School before launching into producing short films.

In Wellington Matthew collaborated with Mark Willis ("What Now?" "Splinter"), as co-writers and co-producers on the film "Blind Panic". The film received New Zealand Film Commission funding to create a concept short and the resulting feature film is currently in post-production. This collaboration was the origin of their company, Pelham Films.

The goal of Pelham Films is to set a new standard for low-budget genre filmmaking in New Zealand. With a wide range of experience on all levels of production, Matthew is always looking for opportunities to get involved with exciting film and TV projects. Pelham's short comedy "Burst" was released in 2020.

British born, award-winning international writer **April Phillips** wrote the screenplay of **The Odds.** She has an acclaimed history of writing for theatre and radio and since completing her Masters Degree in Scriptwriting (International Institute of Modern Letters at Victoria University of Wellington), she has focussed on film. She is one of the most licensed playwrights in New Zealand and her international hit comedy "STIFF" has been produced over 100 times. April has garnered numerous awards and nominations for both stage and screen works, including reaching the top cut of the BlueCat Screenwriting Competition twice. 












# Charley Kryssia ("The Woman")
